



Scheduled to open on July 5th, Telluride's new bike park will be a twisting and rolling web of freeride and cross-country trails designed for people of all ages, abilities and interests. Built in collaboration with Gravity Logic, the British Columbia based leader in bike park development, Telluride's new bike park will have approximately 15 new trails and 17 miles of terrain. The park will be composed of both flow trails with smooth downhill riding and technical trails involving single-track forested surfaces built for a different kind of challenge. The Village Express lift will service the area running from 10am-6pm daily. Passes can be purchased for \$36 per day and will include lift use, bike patrol and options for lessons and guides. Bikes can be rented from a number of nearby locations so that you can hit the course running.

Cruising the trails will be a unique opportunity to get in touch with the Telluride landscape. Take to the park with the family or on a solo mission and get ready to experience our beautiful mountain slopes in summer. This will be an ideal adventure for those in search of fresh air, stunning views and a bit of authentic outdoor exploration.
